

Move If....

Teacher Prep:

Count the number of students. Provide each student with one color of construction paper.

Instructions:

- Ask each participant to stand on one of the sheets of paper.
- Read out loud:
 - I will read one statement. If the statement applies to you, you must quickly move to a new sheet of paper at least 2 spots from where you started. If you find yourself without a sheet of paper, please come to the center of the space.
 - Important: Prepare to remove one sheet of paper immediately after the first statement is read.
- Read the first statement. Remove one sheet of paper.
- The person in the center will answer the question.
- Read the next statement. All participants affected will move. The person in the center will try to find a sheet of paper as soon as the statement has been read.
- Repeat the process.

Move If Statements:

Move if...

- You know what an entrepreneur does. (An entrepreneur is a person who takes a risk to start a business.)
- You know what a good is. (A good is a tangible item you can touch, hold, feel or use to satisfy your wants.)
- You know what a service is. (A service is an action you do for others to satisfy your wants.)
- You know why Arthur started his pet business. (He wanted to show he was responsible to get a puppy.)
- You know how much Arthur would earn by taking care of Perky. (\$10)
- You know what animal Arthur took care of on Tuesday. (He took care of Prunella's ant farm.)
- You know if Doug's Doughnut Shop provides a good or a service. (good)
- You know what pets Arthur began to take care of on Wednesday. (He took care of Brain's frogs.)
- You know what Arthur couldn't do on Saturday because he had his pet business. (He couldn't go to the movies with Buster because he had to clean the cages and feed the animals.)
- You know if Pat's Pet Hotel provides a good or service. (service)
