





## Business Codes

In accordance with the State of New York, the owners of any "teen club" establishment must adhere to the following state and federal guidelines or risk closure for failure to comply with mandatory regulations:

### I. Fire Safety Codes

- A. The establishment must contain 2 regulation fire extinguishers
- B. The establishment must contain 2 regulation smoke detectors
- C. The establishment must contain 2 regulation emergency exit signs

### II. Health & Safety Codes

- A. The establishment must contain 2 first aid kits
- B. The establishment must contain 2 regulation carbon monoxide detectors
- C. The establishment must contain 1 "Automated External Defibrillator or "AED" in case of heart failure
- D. The establishment must contain one "Heimlich Maneuver" poster to guard against choking hazards
- E. The establishment must contain 1 landline telephone to alert authorities in case of emergency

### III. Individuals with Disabilities Codes

- A. The establishment must contain 1 wheelchair access ramp

### IV. Building Inspection Codes

- A. The establishment must hire 1 construction inspector to assess the structural integrity of the building (\$500)
- B. The establishment must hire 1 health inspector to determine if any dangerous materials exist on the premises. (\$400)

### V. Business Permits

- A. The establishment must pay a one-time processing fee to acquire a permit to be put on display (\$100)

### VI. Taxation

- A. The establishment must pay a 5% business sales tax on all initial purchases [Multiply your total expenses by .05 and add this amount]
