

## **Activity 1: Calculating the Unemployment Rate**

The unemployment rate is calculated using the following formula:

<u>Number of unemployed</u> X 100 = unemployment rate Labor force

**Unemployed:** people without jobs who are actively seeking work.

**Labor force**: people who are aged 16 or over and are employed or actively looking for work. In short, the labor force = employed + unemployed.

The number is multiplied by 100 so we can discuss the rate as a percentage.

## Application

Calculate the unemployment rate given the following information:

- The total population is 2000
- Number of people employed: 900
- Number of people unemployed: 100
